DAY 2 KOCHI TO MUNNAR

(Note: No bathing facilities at station, but it will be available at the evening stay)




DAY 3 MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING

- Option to watch Kathakali or Kalaripayattu (martial arts) shows in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Thekkady.


